- We encourage all youth living in social housing communities within Ottawa South East with financial need, to submit an application. However, applicants living within the Ledbury-Banff community will be given preference.
- Applicants must be pursuing some form of post-secondary education (university, college, or trade program) leading to a degree, diploma, apprenticeship or other program certification, at an accredited institute in Canada. - All applicants must be recent high-school graduates who will be entering into their first-year of their post-secondary program in September 2011 or January 2012.

What is The Ledbury-Banff Scholarship Program?

HOW TO APPLY:

The Ledbury-Banff Community Scholarship Program has been created in an effort to promote and encourage youth living within the community to pursue a post-secondary education. Students everywhere are affected by rising tuition fees, and the current economic recession; this economic situation can limit young people's opportunities to continue their education. The Banff Avenue Community House and its partners are committed to ensuring that youth residing in our community will have the support and opportunity to pursue their education, while striving to achieve their goals and fulfill their aspirations.

The Ledbury-Banff Community Scholarship Program will consist of two \$500 entrance scholarships, given to recent high-school graduates entering their first year of study at an accredited post-secondary institution. The scholarship will be applied directly to the student's tuition and paid directly to the post-secondary institution upon confirmation of registration.

The application process requires students to write an essay (500-750 words) outlining the following:

- Your educational and/or life goals and career aspirations.
- Your involvement in the community.
